Through the project 4 short-term joint staff training events will take place in Bulgaria (Sofia), Romania (Bucharest), France (Pau) and Latvia (Ranka, Gulbenes novads) involving teachers, youth workers etc.

These participants will be involved to participate in short-term joint staff training events and knowledge transfer or follow-up activities in every partner country after short-term joint staff training events as multiplayers.
